

Master Institute of United Arts wishes to announce special classes in Pottery, Ceramic Sculpture, and Applied Arts, under the direction of Miss Vally Wieselthier, noted Viennese sculptress and designer. Miss Wieselthier is a graduate of the celebrated Kunstgewerbe Schule in Vienna, and was a leading figure in the Wiener Werkstaette, founding the Ceramic Workshop as a branch of that Institution.

The class in Pottery and Ceramic Sculpture will include the making of various forms on the potter's wheel, the student inventing the forms as he works; the building of shapes and figural sculptures in the hollow, in order to preserve the original dynamic of the surface and to permit firing without casting. Instruction will be given in the mixing of glazes after Miss Wieselthier's own formulae. In this way the student will be taught the entire process from the first steps up to the finished piece of work.

Miss Wieselthier will also conduct classes in the Use of Linoleum and Wood Blocks for Textile Printing, and the Handling of Plaster and Papier-Mache for Wall Decorations.

In both classes free experimentation by the student will be encouraged in order to develop his imaginative expression, and so that he may learn to use the full possibilities of his material in the creation of original shapes and forms without preconceived design.

The tuition fee for each course is \$80 for the season of October to June, payable in two payments, or on a monthly basis of \$10 per month. Enrollment for these classes is now open.
