Classes in painting, drawing, illustration, stage and costume design under the direction of Mr. Hans von Schroetter, prominent Austrian artist and designer.

Mr. von Schroetter studied extensively in Vienna, Munich, Stuttgart, and in 1924 won the Austrian Gold Medal for Art. Since his arrival in this country he has executed commissions for the St. Bonaventura Church in New York City, frescoes for the Chicago World's Fair, and for many prominent organizations.

In Mr. von Schroetter's classes at the Master Institute the students are instructed in the fundamental and advanced problems of composition and design with the aim of applying them to their own individual problems. Draughtsmanship and the use of various media are taught, and an effort is made to develop the students' appreciation of aesthetic values.

The tuition fee is \$15.00 per month for the morning or evening session, held daily from Monday through Friday, mornings from 9 to 12 oclock, and evenings from 7 to 10 oclock, with 2 weekly criticisms.
