

Master Institute of United Arts wishes to announce the formation of special classes in Hammered Art Metal Work, under the direction of James C. Kevlin, well known teacher of metal crafts.

The work in Mr. Kevlin's classes will include the making of jewelry such as bracelets, rings, chains; coasters, fruit bowls, book-ends, trays, vases, etc.

Mr. Kevlin has a special method of simplifying the technic of making art metal objects, and beginners will be enabled to produce fine pieces of work while undergoing an interesting preliminary training. The progress of each student will be facilitated by ample individual attention. The classes are designed to accomodate both children and adults.

Classes will be held Saturday mornings from 10 to 12 A.M., beginning October 5th. The tuition fee for the course is \$45 for the season of October to June, and is payable in two payments, or on a monthly basis of \$6 per month.
