

Master Institute of United Arts is pleased to announce that Mr. Eric Pape, well known American painter, will conduct classes in painting, drawing, portraiture, still life, and composition during the coming season.

Mr. Pape enjoys an excellent reputation as a portraitist, having done portraits of many notable contemporary personages. His works, which also include landscapes, still life and marine paintings, have received places of honor in the leading exhibitions held abroad and in this country.

A brilliant career as an art instructor places Mr. Pape in a leading position in this field, and qualifies him unusually well to direct the work of his students in a constructive and inspiring manner.

The classes will be held daily, in morning, afternoon, and evening sessions, and will embrace life drawing, portraiture, still life, use of various media, and the principles of composition. The tuition fee for any of the sessions is \$120 for the season of October to June, and is payable in two payments of \$60 each, or on the basis of \$15 per month. Enrollment for this class is now open.

The close link of the Master Institute with the Roerich Museum, which contains over one thousand paintings of the world renowned master, Professor Nicholas Roerich, gives the student the unique advantage of studying master-pieces of a noble and pure form of art. Exceptional opportunities are provided for the student in the way of free access to concerts, exhibitions, lectures, dramatic and operatic performances, and the use of a rare art library. Many public presentations of the students' creative efforts are arranged during the school year in the auditoriums of Roerich Museum.
