MORE than ever in history is the world in need of new medical wisdom, the sword of science to combat the advances of human sickness, the scourge of disease. How to advance the outposts of knowledge? Science is becoming increasingly aware that one of the greatest torches in its path is the Ancient Knowledge, the treasures which lie in century-old folk wisdom, native pharmacopaea. No fact could be more eloquent of this than the news of the inauguration of the International Commission of the League of Nations for Research into the Ancient Medicines.

Hence it is one of the greatest boons to know that through the vision and generosity of Nicholas and Helena Roerich, these paths are being opened for intrepid Science in Urusvati, Himalayan Research Institute of Roerich Museum.

The Himalayan Research Institute was founded by Prof. Nicholas Roerich and Mme. Roerich, after their five-year expedition through India, Sikkim, Kashmir, Ladak, Chinese Turkestan, Mongolia and Tibet. Choosing Naggar in the Kulu Valley—undoubtedly the most ideal site in Asia for their work by reason of the ideal combinations of climate, altitudes, atmospheric conditions and fertile soil—Nicholas and Helena Roerich themselves donated the headquarters to the Institute to inaugurate its work. Through their unceasing labor and efforts, the first triennial of the Foundation of Urusvati sees their anticipations fully justified and the work indicates that from its achievements and labors will come vast possibilities for the well-being and the amelioration of human life.

In the three years of its foundation, the Institute has invited to its Honorary Advisory Board such eminent scientific world leaders as Einstein, Millikan, Raman, Bose, and others.

Five expeditions have already been organized under Dr. Walter Koelz, the American biologist and member of the staff, into Lahul, Bashahr, Kangru, Lahore and now Ladak and Zangskar. Thousands of species of plants and fauna have been collected and collections sent to such world institutions as: Bureau of Foreign Seed and Plant Introduction, Dept. of Agriculture, Washington, D.C.; University of Michigan; Harvard University; New York Botanical Garden; and the Jardin des Plantes de Paris.

Already under Dr. George Roerich, eminent Tibetan scholar and member of the staff, and with the cooperation of leading local scholars and others, vital work in the study of books on Tibetan medicines has begun.

And, too, a new Bio-chemical Laboratory is now in process of construction made possible through the generosity of American friends.

So eloquent are the possibilities indicated by the first three years of achievements, and so imperative the need for further funds to carry out a work which is of the utmost significance to the world, that a campaign for a fund of \$200,000 for the Biological work and Bio-chemical Laboratory is now inaugurated, by the Committee for the Biological Laboratory Campaign.

To the end that every individual, however limited his means, may bring his share to this humanitarian aim, Nicholas Roerich, President Founder of the Himalayan Research Institute has contributed the reproduction of his masterpiece "Saint Pantaleimon, the Healer," also his new volume, "Realm of Light" from the sales of which all proceeds shall be devoted to this cause.

With the sums raised it is planned to build new laboratories; to erect an electric plant at the Institute and new buildings for organizing physical, pharmacological and general laboratories; to add new scientists to its staff; to collect and investigate all ancient medical lore and in all other ways that may present themselves, to further the researches at Urusvati aimed to aid the well-being of all humanity and the advancing of human knowledge.

The necessity for further research in Biology and Bio-chemistry *must touch every human heart!* It means new weapons against sickness, new preventions against epidemics, plagues, new knowledge enabling men to be further freed from the fear and consequence of disease. Thus those who contribute to this Fund are furthering the cause of human happiness and assisting mankind in fulfilling its destiny and evolution.
