“PREVENTION THROUGH COOPERATION”

Parents, Educators, Physicians and Clinical Psychologists working together can often prevent many functional nervous and mental diseases.

The Psychological Center commences its 8th year, Oct. 3. It is a clearing house for that large group of intelligent people who will not go to free clinics, but do not know where to turn for advice at *reasonable* rates. The Center recommends Doctors of Medicine or of Clinical Psychology to

- (1) Men and women suffering from “nerves”, despondency, phobias (fears), mental fatigue, etc.
- (2) Parents needing help in problem cases of normal or subnormal children, or adolescents—cases of tics, phobias (fears), thumb-sucking, night terrors, tantrums, stammering, left-handedness, etc.
- (3) Parents seeking Nurses or Governesses trained in the Mental as well as the Physical care of children.
- (4) Parents wishing advice in the choice of school or college for their children.
- (5) Parents wishing intelligence or vocational tests, to assist them in choosing a profession or course of study for their children.
- (6) Men and women desiring lectures in Psychology, or courses in Adult Education.
